Wi-Fi Internet Access Policy

Patrons are welcome to use the wi-fi internet. The password is available at the patron computer desk or from the staff or volunteer on duty.

- a. May not use the computers for illegal purposes, in support of illegal activities, or for any other activity prohibited by library policy or procedures
- b. Will comply with all fair use and copyright regulations
- c. May not post on-line photos or videos that are taken at the library, and which contain other patrons, without direct consent of the patron(s)
- d. May not install, download, use or copy software to the computer. The Library provides selected software and printers. The software shall be designed for informational, educational, or recreational uses.
- e. Saved user files on the computers are deleted regularly. User files may be saved to a storage device.
- f. Shall not gain or attempt to gain unauthorized access to resources or information, or do anything to circumvent network security.
- g. may not access data for which they are not an intended recipient or user
- h. must scan all removable media (ex,. flash drives, ipod, etc) for viruses prior to use on the library network

The Library is not responsible for damage to the user's storage device or computer, or for any loss of data, damage, or liability that may be incurred from the customer's use of the library's computers.
